The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) of 1974 protects students by prohibiting unwarranted disclosure by the college of student/education records.

The following items of information regarding a student's record have been defined by Mott Community College as directory information. Directory information is considered public information and may be released without the student's prior consent.

- Name, address, date and place of birth, and telephone number
- Major field of study, dates of attendance, degrees, and awards received
- Most recent educational agency or institution attended
- Participation in officially recognized activities and sports
- Weight and height of members of athletic teams
- Photographs and Videos taken of the student by the college
- Photographs and videos provided by the student to the college

Filing this form will preclude the College from releasing directory information to anyone without express written consent.

I understand:

- this prohibits Mott Community College from acknowledging any information regarding my enrollment to any third part including employers, loan deferments, requests from non-institutional persons/organization unless written request with my signature is received.
- this does not prevent disclosure to personnel within the college or a lawfully issued subpoena.
- this suppresses my information verbally and in printed form (i.e. Commencement, Dean's List).
